

INTERNATIONAL MIGRATION AND DEVELOPMENT

Information on the General Assembly High-level Dialogue 14–15 September 2006, UN Headquarter, New York

The UN General Assembly in its resolution 58/208 of 23 December 2003 decided to devote a high-level dialogue to international migration and development during its sixty-first session in 2006. The purpose of the high-level dialogue is to discuss the multidimensional aspects of international migration and development and identify appropriate ways to maximize its development benefits and minimize its negative impacts. Additionally, the high-level dialogue will have a strong focus on policy issues, including the challenge of achieving internationally agreed development goals, including the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs).

Format

The High-level Dialogue is composed of four plenary meetings and four interactive round tables. The outcome of the High-level Dialogue will be the Chairperson's summary.

Plenary meetings

The plenary meetings take place on 14 and 15 September 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. and 3 to 6 p.m. in the General Assembly Hall. At the opening meeting, the President of the General Assembly, the President of the Economic and Social Council and the Secretary-General deliver introductory statements. Governments are expected to participate at the ministerial or highest level possible.

Roundtables

Member States, Permanent Observers, intergovernmental entities, non-governmental organizations, civil society and the private sector will participate in four closed roundtables. They are on the following themes:

- Effects of international migration on economic and social development
- Measures to ensure respect for and protection of the human rights of all migrants, and to prevent and combat smuggling of migrants and trafficking in persons
- Multidimensional aspects of international migration and development including remittances
- Promoting the building of partnerships and capacity-building and the sharing of best practices at all levels, including the bilateral and regional levels, for the benefit of countries and migrants alike
