The massive scale of extreme poverty at a time of unprecedented wealth is a moral scandal. Poverty is exacerbated by structural injustices in the global economy. At the halfway point towards the target date of the Millennium Development Campaign, there is an urgent need to not only fulfill the pledges, but in some instances, to exceed the commitments made to meet the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs) by 2015.

Religions for Peace is collaborating with the UN Millennium Campaign to facilitate the dynamic partnerships of world's religious communities as key partners in the effort to realize the MDGs and that their voices are heard during the High-level Event on the MDGs to be convened by the UN Secretary-General and the President of the UN General Assembly at UN Headquarters in New York on 25 September 2008.

Religions for Peace in partnership with the UN Millennium Campaign will hold a consultation between Heads of States and senior religious leaders on September 24 to advocate for accelerating implementation and follow-through efforts to meet the Goals.

Purpose: The consultation will advance partnership between governments and religious sector to eliminate poverty through the MDGs.

Outcome: The consultation will provide a forum for religious and political leaders to come together in joint advocacy. A shared multi-religious statement will be issued and widely disseminated to generate commitments to scale up efforts to achieve the Goals and eliminate poverty. A media event will also be held.

Participants: Senior religious leaders from around the world, Heads of States, UN Representative and UN agencies will participate.
