- What do we need to do to reach water-related targets by 2015?
- How can we help the decision making process to achieve the MDGs? What is needed? Better assessment, more data and information? What is the role of international legislation and the UN in this debate?
- What should we be aiming for after 2015 new targets and new commitments? The same commitments for a later achievement date?
- How can water be mainstreamed in processes such as the MDGs and Rio+20?

A moderated panel of experts will discuss these and other issues with the audience.
