What's been done:

- ✓ <u>Development of a website and a newspaper</u> (great tools!)
- ✓ <u>Lectures</u>: to introduce SWITCH and its objectives to new groups. In general using slides about the other SWITCH cities, about climate changes, about the importance on discussing and changing paradigms in water management.
- ✓ <u>Technical presentations</u>: a power point presentation with draws and diagrams shows new ways on urban water management. Schematic wetlands and rainfall collectors are showed to simplify understanding.
- ✓ <u>Group dynamics</u>: for some groups, after the first contact with the project, we do some kind of dynamic to firm knowledge and to continue capture interest.







- ✓ <u>Children activities</u>: games and competitions about water themes.
- ✓ <u>Movies</u>: in special occasions/situations, to make the learning lighter and cooler, we show movies about water/environment/climate changes...











Typical steps of the LA's represented as a cycle

A survey over perception on social and urban environment was applied, with the help of public health workers and two French MSc students who came to Brazil specially to develop this research.

As the implantation work of 10 de Maio, Nossa Senhora da Piedade and Baleares Parks – all projects from DRENURBS Program – were concluded, Belo Horizonte starts the revitalization of it's creeks.
