PRE-PRINTED GROUNDS PASSES

Dear Organizations with pre-registered representatives for CSW57,

We are pleased to announce that the grounds passes of registered NGO representatives who attended any of the previous four sessions of the Commission on the Status of Women will be printed prior to check-in. A prerequisite for this service is that all data on these representatives was entered correctly on CSO-Net. They will be available for pick-up from Friday, 1 March onwards in the General Assembly Lobby (see diagram), upon presentation of an official photo ID (passport if you are travelling from abroad) and the United Nations grounds pass form that was printed from CSO-Net. The representatives concerned have been notified by email.

All other registered NGO representatives will check-in in the General Assembly Lobby (see diagram) and be photographed by Security Officers for their grounds pass.

NGO representatives who hold valid grounds passes issued in New York, be they annual ECOSOC or DPI passes, are expected to use these for CSW57.

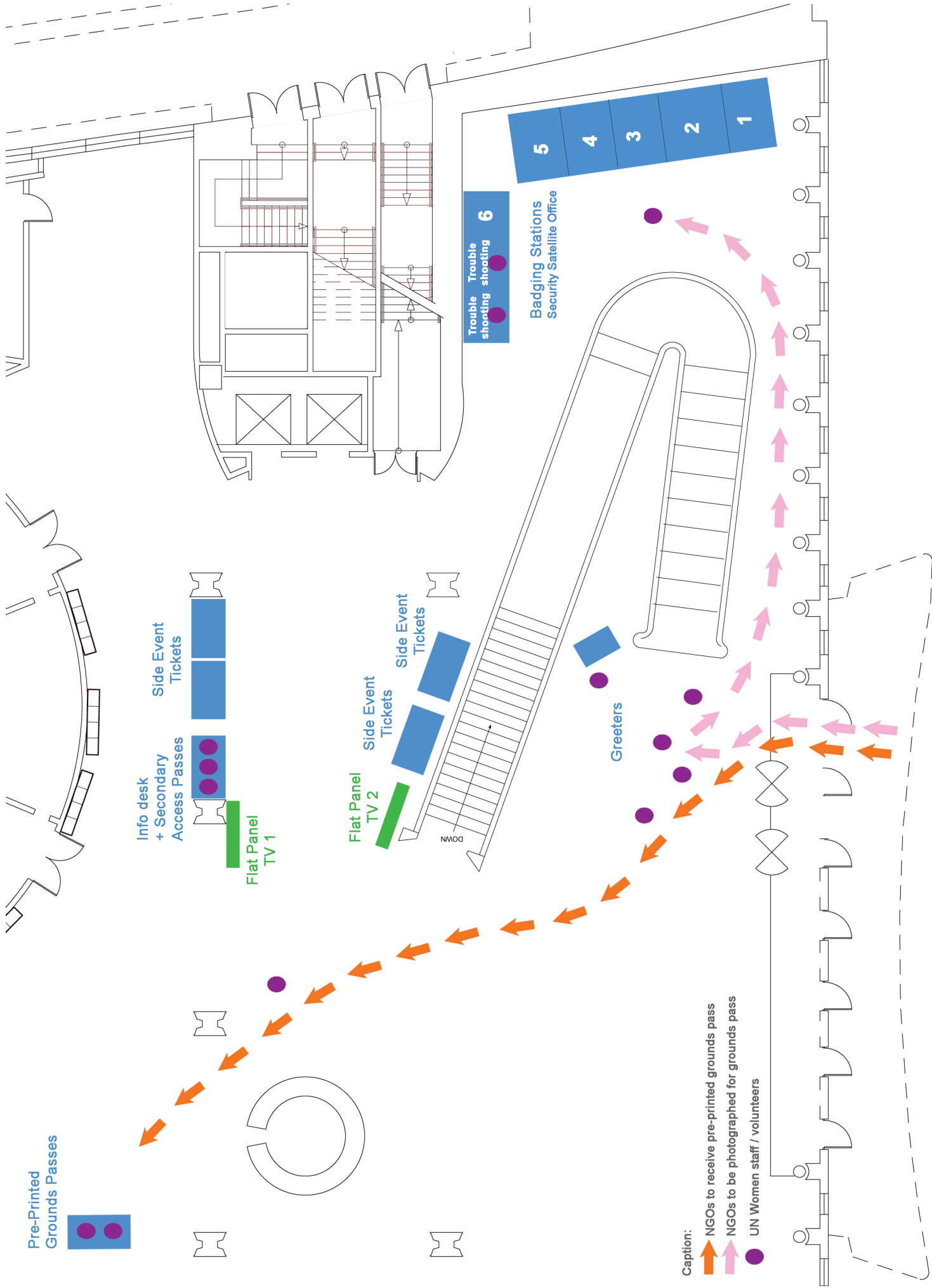
