The National Association of Women Organisations in Uganda (NAWOU)

would like to present Key issues the study should be addressing:

- There is need to protect women with disabilities and in particular those with mental health problems.
- Rape cases, which are sexual violence against women, should be treated as emergencies in hospitals, and be examined for sexually transmitted diseases and treated.
- Police surgeons are mostly male, so females are further inconvenienced when they have issues of sexual violence to present.
- There is need for investing resources (time, human and financial) in raising awareness on practices that cause psycho-social problems. For example verbal abuse, touching of a females body, where they are not willing partners.
